5th Grade Supply Checklist

- 1 pack filler paper (wide-ruled) **or** 1 ream of white paper

- 1 large glue stick

- 3 marble composition notebooks (not spiral bound) identified with child's name and labeled:

- 1 pack of sticky notes (Post-its)
- 1 pack of erasable pens (blue or black ink)
- 1 red pen
- 1 pack #2 pencils (not mechanical)

- 1 box of baby wipes (boy bring this)
- 1 box of Clorox wipes (girls bring this)
- 1 box of tissues
