The program targets reading and writing, as well as, organization, learning strategies and expected classroom behavioral skills within the classroom in **grades K-5**. Through a **push-in** (a large or small group within their classroom) and **pull-out** (students are pulled into a small resource room in order to work on more specific goals) approach, the ESE teacher is able to target specific reading goals and assist students in achieving their academic goals while using school-wide data, classroom curriculum, targeted executive functioning skills, The Science of Reading fundamentals and multi-sensory approaches.
